

侵襲性黴菌感染治療之新進展：確定性治療之藥物選擇

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Invasive fungal infections are common in modern medical practices because increasing trends of using broad-spectrum antimicrobial agents and decreasing host immunity by invasive chemotherapy and procedures. Several significant changes of concepts in the management of invasive candidiasis and infections caused by molds, include the investigation of new anti-fungal agents and laboratory diagnosis. In this discussion, we will focus on published international guidelines (ECIL and IDSA) Taiwan Antifungal Treatment Guideline. Most of these changes relate to the appropriate use of echinocandins and expanded spectrum azoles in the management of candidemia and invasive aspergillosis.
