Peter Meredith is currently Reader in Clinical Pharmacology in the Department of Medicine and Therapeutics of the University of Glasgow. He has held this appointment since 1997 having previously been a Lecturer and Senior Lecturer in the Department of Materia Medica of the same university.

He is based in the Gardiner Institute of the Western Infirmary, Glasgow, where most of his teaching commitments and research is undertaken. His principal research interests are in hypertension and various aspects of clinical cardiovascular pharmacology.

His publication list includes over 280 peer reviewed papers in leading international journals predominantly in hypertension and clinical pharmacology.

He is a former executive editor of the British Journal of Clinical Pharmacology and serves on the editorial boards of the Journal of Hypertension, Blood Pressure, Annals of Experimental and Clinical Medicine and Xenobiotica.

He is a member of the UK Committee of Safety of Medicines which advises the UK Licensing Authority (the UK Health Ministers) with regard to the safety, quality and efficacy in relation to human use of any substance or article to which any provision of the Medicines Act 1968 is applicable.

He was also Director of Research and Development in the West Glasgow Hospitals University NHS Trust from 1997 to 2000.

He was elected to be a Fellow of the Royal Society of London in February 2006.
