

Prof Toshiro Fujita

Professor Toshiro Fujita is Chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine and Chief of the Department of Nephrology and Endocrinology at the University of Tokyo.

Professor Fujita received his MD from Keio University School of Medicine in Tokyo, Japan, in 1972. Following his 4-year internship and residency at Keio University Hospital, Professor Fujita worked as a research and clinical fellow at the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI) of National Institute of Health in Maryland, USA, from 1976 to 1978. In 1980, Fujita and Bartter demonstrated the pathophysiology of salt-sensitive hypertension. Since then, he has been continuing research on metabolic aspects of hypertension. His research interests include endocrinology, metabolic science and cardioangiology.

A renowned expert in his fields, Professor Fujita has been actively contributing to professional associations and scientific publications. Currently, Professor Fujita is the President of both the Japanese Society of Hypertension and Japanese Society of Internal Medicine. In addition, he serves as the Chief Editor of *Hypertension Research*, a position he has held since 2002. He is also Consulting Editor for *Hypertension*, and Corresponding Editor for *American Journal of Hypertension*.
