Achievements:

- description of the defect in signal transduction in T cells from patients with systemic lupus erythematosus and partial correction of this defect with lithium in vitro;
- description of internal organ involvement in patients with systemic sclerosis without overt manifestations of the disease;
- studies on systemic vasculitis;
- optimalization of biological therapy in patients with rheumatoid arthritis.
