Dr. Wan-Cheng Tan is Professor in the Department of Medicine, University of British Columbia, BC, Canada and the Division of Respiratory Medicine, St Paul's Hospital, Vancouver, BC, Canada. Prior to that she was Professor of Medicine at the National University of Singapore and Consultant Physician and Pulmonologist at the National University Hospital in Singapore.

Dr Tan is a Past President of the Asian Pacific Society of Respirology (APSR).

Dr Tan is Chairperson of the Dissemination Committee and member of the Executive Committee of the Global Initiative on Asthma (GINA) and an advisory member of the Global Initiative for Obstructive Lung Disease (GOLD). She also serves as a member of the advisory group to the World Lung Health committee and the International Relations Committee of the American Thoracic Society.

An author of over 130 publications in peer-reviewed journals, Dr Tan also serves as Editorial Board Member and Reviewer for various journals, including Respiratory Medicine, Journal of COPD, Journal of the IUATLD, Respirology, and CHEST.

She has major research interests in the prevalence, mortality and risk factors of hospitalization in COPD; in the long term effects of inhaled steroids in mild asthma, and global implementation of asthma guidelines. She is the lead investigator for the BOLD [Burden of Obstructive Lung Disease] study in Canada.
